Kindergarten Registration

Shoshone School District Kindergarten Registration for the 2023-2024 school year will be held in our kindergarten classrooms on Wednesday, April 19, 5:00-7:30 p.m. Please bring your child with you when registering him/her for kindergarten. Registration and screening will take approximately 45 minutes.

In order to register your child for kindergarten he/she must turn 5 on or before September 1, 2023 (no exceptions). To complete registration, parents must provide child's <u>official</u> state birth certificate and current or completed immunization record. Children must be current on their immunizations to register. If your child is not current on their immunizations, please call South Central Public Health District at 737-5966 to make an appointment.

If you do not have an official birth certificate and your child was born in Idaho, you may obtain one from Idaho Vital Statistics, P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho 83720-0036 (208-334-5988) or by going online at www.vitalrecords.dhw.idaho.gov.

If your child was born in another state, we have addresses for each of the state's Bureau of Vital Statistics. Please call the school elementary office at 886-2381 ext. 138 for information. Please remember that we need the official birth certificate not a hospital certificate.

Child Find Screening for 3-5-year-olds

We will hold pre-eligibility screening for 3-5 year olds on Wednesday, April 19, 5:00-7:00 p.m. The purpose of this screening is to help us identify resident 3-5-year-old children delayed in learning. This delay could be due to social skills, self-care needs, physical development, gross/fine motor skills or in speech and language.

This service is available to only resident, 3-5-year-old children. To be eligible for testing your child must turn three before May 31, 2023 or five after September 1, 2023. If you have developmental concerns about your preschool child, please call our elementary office at 886-2381 ext. 138 so we can schedule a screening appointment. The screening will take approximately 45 minutes.

I.S.A.T. Testing for Grades 3-5

ISAT testing for grades 3-5 will begin at 8:30 a.m. on April 11, 12, 18, 19. Students will test on their math, reading and language skills. Fifth grade students will have one additional test for science on May 2. Each test takes approximately 2 hours to complete. ISAT testing is very important so please help your child do the best they can by getting them to bed early on testing nights. If they do not eat breakfast at school please feed them a good breakfast at home, and please make any appointments for them after school.
